

SERIES OVERVIEW

In the six-part series Breaking Boundaries, six breakers discover the hip hop culture in different cities around the world.

In every episode we follow each breaker as a host in a big metropole in their home country, and learn about their lives and background stories. Every B- Boy and B-Girl's story is unique, and the contrasts between them show us how diverse the global breaking culture is.

In the destination cities the breakers are divided into hosts and guests, where one will take on the other and show them their culture, lifestyle and country.

They will take a deep dive into the city's hip hop culture with a strong focus on break dancing.

During the trips the pairs connect with local personalities in distinct neighbourhoods, learning everything there is to know about the culture in a part of the world they hadn't yet discovered.

Sharing experiences and dancing together, the breakers bring new moves and perspectives to the local communities, while also taking back home new stories and skills to share with their own friends, families and other breakers they then welcome to their city.




SAO PAOLO, BRAZIL
